Minutes of a meeting of the Highways and Road Safety Committee held at Langrish School Hall on Tuesday 1st of March 2016 at 7.00pm.

HC4.03.15 To Receive and Approve the Minutes of the Meeting on the 19th January 2016: Minutes of the Meeting held on the 19th of January 2016 previously circulated were agreed and signed.

HC5.03.15 Update on the Site Visit with Hampshire County Council:

Cllr Burges, Cllr Foulston, Cllr McKinney and Mrs A Snow met with Mr Ian Janes and Cllr Vaughan Clarke of Hampshire County Council at a site visit at Ramsdean Road and the A272 on Friday 26th February. Currently there is no definitive plan regarding traffic improvements in Stroud but suggestions include redoing the road surface at both entrances to the village (with no increase to tyre noise on the new surface), removal of some lines on the road, amalgamated and larger road signs and highlighting the crossroads. Hampshire County Council will be monitoring the traffic before and after the improvement works take place. The works potentially will take place in late Spring or early Summer. Mr Janes will confirm when the definitive plan and date of the works are available. **It was resolved** that following the site visit, the letter to parents and carers at Langrish School would be amended to take account of the discussion and that the possibility of an article in the Petersfield Post would be revisited after the works had started. Future improvement requests would also be revisited at that time. **It was resolved** to contact Hampshire Constabulary for further information regarding speeding statistics and whether these could be publicised on signs in the village.

Cllr Burges also confirmed that a meeting had taken place regarding a new School Travel Plan.

Mr Llewellyn will be contacting Damian Hinds MP regarding noise pollution in the village.

It was resolved that Cllr Burges would present an update regarding this committee and road safety improvements at the Annual Parish Meeting in April.
