## Minutes of a meeting of the Highways and Road Safety Committee held at Stroud Church on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> of December 2015 at 7.45pm.

**HC1.01.15 Election of Chairman:** Cllr Burges was elected Chairman – proposed by Cllr Foulston and seconded by Cllr Howe

**HC5.01.15 To Discuss Draft Letters to be Sent to Relevant Authorities:**

The Clerk had drafted letters to be sent to Hampshire County Council, the Local Education Authority, Damian Hinds and Hall & Woodhouse. Following discussion, and subject to minor amendments, **it was resolved** that the letters would be sent as soon as possible. Mrs Snow would also provide photographs to be included with the letters. Cllr Burges also confirmed that the school travel plan was currently being looked into by the new head teacher of Langrish School.

**HC6.01.15 To Agree How To Raise Awareness of this Issue and this Committee:**

Mrs Snow has notified Langrish School of the formation of this committee and Cllr Burges will also raise this at the school governor's meeting. **It was resolved** to add information to the Parish Council and village websites and also the Steep & Stroud newsletter. A potential article in the Petersfield Post or a letter drop were also discussed.

After discussion **it was resolved** that the police would be contacted to ask for statistics and also to ask for an update at a future meeting. The sub-committee would also like to work closely with Langrish School on these issues. It was also discussed that a future priority could be to speak to Hampshire County Council about linking options such as speed cameras and signs with a potential school patrol crossing and whether this was possible.
