



# Stroud Parish Council

## Minutes of a meeting of the Highways and Road Safety Committee held at Stroud Church on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> of September 2016 at 7.00pm.

**HC1.03.16 Apologies for Absence:** None

**HC2.03.16 Declaration of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests:** None

**HC3.03.16 Comments from the Public or Press:** None

**HC4.03.16 To Receive and Approve the Minutes of the Meeting on the 6<sup>th</sup> of September 2016:** Minutes of the Meeting held on the 6<sup>th</sup> of September 2016 previously circulated were agreed and signed.

**HC5.03.16 Update Following a Recent Meeting with Hampshire County Council:**  
Cllr Burges confirmed that he had met with Ian Janes of Hampshire County Council. Further road improvements discussed, and due to take place, were changing the position of the pedestrians sign in Ramsdean Road, removing the cat's eyes holders and repairing works completed following a water leak. Ian Janes confirmed that signs showing number of speeding fines issued weren't currently possible.

**HC6.03.16 To Discuss Installing Speed Signs:**  
Cllr Burges also discussed the installation of flashing speed signs with Ian Janes and Mr Janes offered to help towards the costs of the post as much as possible under budget constraints for the following financial year. The suggested system was 3 sockets with 1 post to be reversed on a regular basis. Moving the signs would be the responsibility of a working party of local residents. A discussion followed regarding where the sockets should be situated and Cllr Burges will revisit this with Ian Janes and mark the suggested points on a map of the village. The signs record data which is then forwarded on to the police. The total cost to install the speed signs is approximately £4k and **it was resolved** to forward this to full Council as a project for the 17/18 financial year and to also look into grants for this. Cllr Burges also reported that he has requested access to go out with the police on an occasion where they are monitoring speeding on the A272.

**HC7.03.16 Update on Correspondence with the Road Safety Unit:**  
Cllr Foulston reported that the Safer Roads Unit had responded regarding the decibel reader request and had confirmed that there was no meter available and that currently there was nothing further they could do. They suggested that the request was resent to the Police & Crime Commissioner and **it was resolved** that Cllr Foulston would do this.

**HC9.03.16 To Decide the Date of the Next Meeting:**
